General Policies

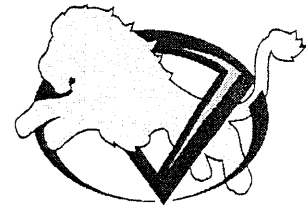
Victory World Christian School (VWCS) believes that an integral part of providing a Christ-centered, academically excellent education, is establishing an environment of learning where children and adults can both experience and express the gospel of Jesus Christ. God has a heart for children and He calls believers to “become like children” and exhorts his disciples to care for every child. While parents are ultimately responsible for their child’s development physically, emotionally, intellectually, socially, and spiritually, they are not expected to do this task alone. Victory World Church (VWC) and VWCS are committed to nurturing families towards Christ-likeness so that the great commission is fulfilled. Developing Godly self-discipline is important in growing spiritually and intellectually so VWCS employs graduated forms of discipline when behavioral expectations are not met. All discipline is grounded and balanced by biblical principles of love, justice, restitution, restoration, reconciliation, mercy, and grace.

During the start-up phase (first few years) VWCS will be unable to accommodate students with severe learning disabilities, severe hyperactivity, severe emotional disturbances, severe visual or hearing impairment, or profound mental retardation.

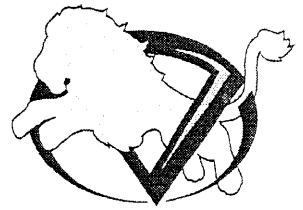

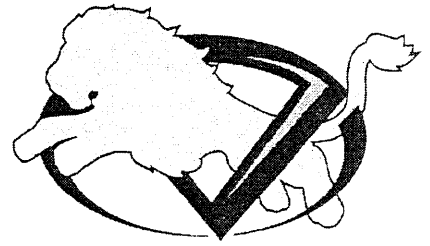

Statement of Faith

The Scriptures... The Bible is the inspired Word of God, the product of men of old who spoke and wrote as they were moved by the Holy Spirit. The New Covenant, as recorded in the New Testament, we accept as our infallible guide in matters pertaining to conduct and doctrine. (I Timothy 3:16; I Thess. 2:13; II Peter 1:21)

The Trinity... There is one God, eternally existent in three persons—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit being coequal (I John 5:6-8; Philippians 2:6). God the Father is the sender of the Word the Begetter (John 16:28, John 1:14). The Son is the Word made flesh, the One Begotten, and has existed with the Father from the beginning (John 1:1; John 1:18; John 1:14). The Holy Spirit proceeds forth from both the Father and the Son and is eternal (John 15:26).

Man, his fall and redemption... Man is a created being, made in the likeness and image of God, but through Adam's transgressions and fall, sin came into the world. "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God". "As it is written, there is none righteous, no, not one." Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was manifested to undo the work of the devil and gave His life and shed his blood to redeem and restore man back to God (Romans 5:14; Romans 3:10 & 23; I John 3:8). Salvation is the gift of God to man, separate from works and the law, and is made operative by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, producing work acceptable to God (Ephesians 2:8).

Eternal life and the new birth... Man's first step toward salvation is godly sorrow through repentance. The New Birth is necessary for all men, and when experienced produces eternal life (Corinthians 7:10; I John 5:12; John 3:3-5; Romans 10:9-10).

Hell and eternal retribution... The one who physically dies in his sins without accepting Christ is hopelessly and eternally lost in the Lake of Fire and, therefore, has no further opportunity of hearing the Gospel or repenting. The Lake of Fire is literal, the terms "eternal" and "everlasting", used in describing the duration of the punishment of the damned in the Lake of Fire, carry the same through and meaning of endless existence as used in denoting the duration of joy and ecstasy of the saints in the presence of God (Hebrews 9:27; Revelation 20:15).

Water baptism... Baptism in water by immersion is a direct commandment of our Lord, and is for believers only. The ordinance is a symbol of the Christian's identification with Christ death, burial, and resurrection (Matthew 28:19; Romans 6:4; Colossians 2:12; Acts 8:36-39).

Baptism in the Holy Ghost... The full consummation of the Baptism of believers in the Holy Ghost is evidenced by the initial physical sign of speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gives utterance, and by the subsequent manifestation of Spiritual Power in public testimony and service. (Acts 2:4; Acts 10:44-46; Acts 19:6; Acts 1:18; Acts 2:42-43; Matthew 3:11).

Sanctification... The Bible teaches that without holiness no man can see the Lord. We believe in the Doctrine of Sanctification as a definite, yet progressive work of grace, commencing at the time of regeneration, and continuing until the consummation of salvation at Christ's return (Hebrew 12:14; I Thessalonians 5:23; II Peter 3:18; Philippians 3:12-14; I Corinthians 1:30).

Divine healing... Healing is for the physical ills of the human body and is brought by the power of God through the prayer of faith, and/or by the laying on of hands. It is provided for in the atonement of Christ, and is the privilege of every member of the Church today (Mark 16:18; James 5:14-15; I Peter 2:24; Matthew 8:17; Isaiah 53:4-5).

Resurrection of the just and the return of our Lord... The angels said to Jesus' disciples, "This same Jesus shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into Heaven." His coming is imminent. When He comes, "...the dead in Christ shall rise first; then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air..." (Acts 1:11; I Thessalonians 4:16-17). Following the Tribulation, He shall return to earth as King of kings, and Lord of lords, and together with His saints, who shall be kings and priests, He shall reign a thousand years (Revelation 20:6).
